It's a common complaint among learners of Luxembourgish in the capital--it's one thing to learn a language but where can one practise it?

The [Théâtre National du Luxembourg](#) and [Learn Luxembourgish](#) may have the answer. Together they are organising free monthly chat nights, or Poterowend, where Luxembourgers and non-Luxembourgers alike can practise speaking Luxembourgish.



The next Poterowend takes place on 28 November 2019 at the TNL

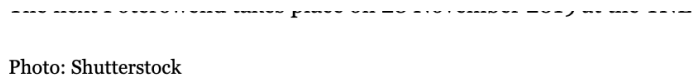

“Usually, Learn Luxembourgish is focused around virtual education through Skype and online courses, but lately, we have been feeling like getting a little more personal. Sometimes it’s good to meet face-to-face,” says virtual learning school founder Liz Wenger.

Wenger adds that participants are free to talk about any topic of their choosing but each evening will also run under a specific theme so that people taking part do not run out of material to talk about and to keep conversations varied and interesting.

Being able to speak a little bit of Luxembourgish already is a plus but it is not necessary as a prerequisite to participate, says Wenger. “Even if you don’t know a single Luxembourgish word yet--it won’t take long before you’re introducing yourself in Luxembourgish!”

Poterowend events start at 7pm at the TNL, 194 route de Longwy, L-1940, Luxembourg-Merl. No prior registration is required--attendees can just turn up and get talking. The bar is open during the evening.
